- The Club also sponsors boating-oriented social events such as youth and adult fishing tournaments, flotilla cruises to shelling beaches, lunch or dinner by boat in town, etc.
- The Club also encourages safe boating by arranging courtesy safety inspections and sponsoring boating classes for both children and adults.
